SUMMARY

The Discipleship Pastor is responsible for the implementation of the mission of Redemption to make disciples and the overall leadership of the church staff. This includes the execution and implementation of the Senior Pastor and Elder's vision in areas of ministry development, organizational integration, and operational oversight. Areas of oversight and direction include discipleship, biblical counseling, worship, assimilation, communications, missions, and operations.
