POSITION SUMMARY

The Worship Arts Pastor is a godly man who is a gifted individual with a heart to seek after God and to lead our church family in glorifying God through singing, praising, and worshiping.

REQUIREMENTS & RESPONSIBILITIES

Realizing that all of us are in the process of becoming like Jesus Christ (2 Corinthians 3:18) and that we all have areas where we need to grow in ministry, it is our prayer that God will raise up a man who will accept the following responsibilities and will have the following qualifications:

- 1. He is to be a man with a clear testimony of faith in our Lord Jesus Christ, whose reputation is that of being a man of the Word and prayer.
- 2. He is to be a man who meets the qualifications of an elder (in accordance with 1 Timothy 3:1-7; Titus 1:5-9).
- 3. He is to model the spiritual, worship, and musical attitudes and standards that are to characterize the entire music and worship ministry of this church.
- 4. He is to serve as a part of a pastoral team and a church family, demonstrating a willingness to give of his time, talent, and treasures to serve this local church.
- 5. He is to be in full agreement with (and willing to sign) the Doctrinal Statement of this local church.
- 6. He is to be familiar with and willing to follow the guidelines of the Constitution and By-Laws of this local church.
- 7. He is to operate within the policies established by the Board of Elders for implementation by the pastoral and ministerial staff.
- 8. He is to provide oversight of all music ministries (e.g. choirs, orchestras, ensembles, praise teams, etc.).

- 9. He is to oversee the recruitment of participants for the music and creative ministries of this church.
- 10. He is to develop and submit a proposed annual budget for all of the ministries over which he has oversight.
- 11. He is to work with the Student and Children's Ministries staff in developing effective music, drama, and creative ministry training and opportunities for service.
- 12. He is to work with the Senior Pastor and assigned staff in the coordination of all regular and special worship services.
- 13. He is to provide oversight of the audio-visual department.
- 14. He is to provide oversight of the Welcome Team (Ushers, Greeters, Information Center, etc.)
- 15. He is to provide oversight of the Drama Ministry and other Creative Ministries.
- 16. He is to actively develop an effective Music/Worship Committee whose responsibility is to assist him in the implementation of the ministry.
- 17. He is to participate in pastoral staff meetings.
- 18. He is to perform other pastoral duties as assigned by the Senior Pastor.
- 19. He is to be immediately responsible to the Senior Pastor.
- 20. He is to maintain regular church office hours, as arranged by the Senior Pastor.
- 21. He is to be ultimately responsible to the Lord Jesus Christ for the fulfillment of this ministry.

2. His Competence

a. Shepherding

- (1) He must have the proven ability to equip others.
- (2) He must have the proven ability to train leaders.
- (3) He must have proven ability in counseling and discipling.
- (4) He must have the proven ability in the Word and theology.
- (5) He must have experience partnering with other local and global ministries.
- (6) He must be qualified to be licensed or ordained to the ministry.
- (7) He must have at least three years of proven experience serving as a pastor in a local church.
- (8) He must have a proven ability to humbly lead as a man under authority.
- (9) He must meet the leadership qualifications (found in 1 Tim 3:1-7 & Titus 1:5-9).

b. Music

- (1) He must have the proven ability in leading an orchestra.
- (2) He must have the proven ability in choir and ensemble directing.
- (3) He must be skilled in leading blended-style service.
- (4) He must have skill in leading a congregation in worship.
- (5) He must have skills in music theory and arranging.
- (6) He must have a proven ability to administrate music ministries.
- (7) He must be skilled in developing a music staff.
- (8) He must be skilled in managing a budget.

c. Education

- (1) He must have at least a bachelor's degree in music or able to show proven competency.
- (2) He must have some degree or certificate in Bible Training from a reputable institution (30 units preferable) or show proven competence in his knowledge of the Word.

3. His Chemistry

- a. He must demonstrate compatibility with Senior Pastor, staff, and Worship Arts Committee in regard to the ministry direction and philosophies.
- b. He must have musical credibility with our strongest musicians.
- c. He must be willing to serve at least five years in this local church unless otherwise mutually agreed upon by you and the church leadership.
