Silver Spur Christian Camp

In August, we sold Silver Spur Christian Camp and Retreat Center located in Tuolumne, CA. In 1965, our church association purchased this property to provide a year-round camp for churches, schools, and other non-profit organizations. For 58 years, it operated with the mission to create an engaging environment where people learned and experienced the grace and truth of Jesus Christ. At the time of its sale, Silver Spur spanned 135 acres and could accommodate groups of 20-320 people. We are grateful for the opportunities the camp provided us to impact churches, ministries, and people in advancing the Kingdom of God. I desire that we become known as the most generous church organization in our region with our time, energy, experience, and resources. The sale of Silver Spur will enable us to continue our mission to honor God and serve our region.

Preaching Cohorts

Ministry Leadership Certificate (MLC)

I took over this role from Josh Lane a little over a year ago. My primary responsibility is directing the Ministry Leadership Certificate (MLC) program.

The MLC program was designed to be a tool for churches to help equip their saints for the work of ministry. I have sent people from my church through the program every year since it started and have seen its benefits. I was excited to take over the direction of the program!

I spent last spring working to refresh the program. I rewrote the syllabus, changed the required reading lists, and updated the assignments. All of the video content for this program is provided to us by Western Seminary. I worked with the distance learning director at Western Seminary to adjust our courses to create a more integrated learning experience.

The MLC is divided into two cohorts: one that is based in N. California and one that meets at Campus Bible Church in Fresno, CA. This year, both cohorts locations have seen our largest attendance in years!

My goal for the future is to offer this program to a broader audience. At this point, it has mostly been provided to VCN churches. While the content is seminary-level, I believe that it could be accessible to high school or college students who are looking for a deeper understanding of God's word.

I would also like to see the cohort model that Campus Bible Church uses employed in other larger churches or regions. I enjoy the increased camaraderie and accountability when several students are all in the same location.

AB-506 Legislation

The new California legislation (AB506) requires employees, administrators, and volunteers of youth-serving organizations (including houses of worship, schools, daycares, and nonprofits) to complete training in child abuse and neglect reporting and undergo Live Scan background checks. Pastor Mike Klockenbrink, business administrator at Lakeside Church in Folsom, CA, held a seminar that has helped many churches find state compliance.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Financial Summary

There has been a significant improvement in our financial position since last year. This is due to the sale of Silver Spur, which was final on July 27, 2023. Before the sale, VCN NCal/NV averaged a monthly net loss of around \$23,000 due to Silver Spur Camp expenses. Insurance alone has gone from \$14,886 a month down to \$932 a month. We are budgeted to have an average net income of around \$7,900 each month in 2024. We are now in a better position to come alongside our churches as they take BOLD next steps to reach their communities with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Below is a summary of our financial position as of November 30, 2023 and 2022.
